LEAF COLLECTION

Curbside leaf collection is once per week in the Spring (April through May), and in the Fall (October through November).

Leaves must be placed at curbside Monday mornings prior to 6:30 am.

Leaf pickup will start Monday and continue throughout the week.

Leaves must be placed in recyclable, biodegradable brown leaf bags (such as Union Camp, RCI or comparable bag). Bags are available for purchase at Home Depot, Stop & Shop, Sears and similar stores. Leaves may also be placed loose in trash cans provided the cans are no larger than 32 gal and weigh no more than 50 lbs. when filled. It is helpful to label leaf cans. No plastic bags will be accepted at curbside.

Curbside leaf collection also includes small brush (plants, shrubs and tree branches). Brush must not exceed four feet in length and two inches in diameter and must be tied and bundled, placed in leaf bags or in cans.

Leaves and small brush are accepted throughout the year at the Recycling Center and must be debagged when dumped.

NO LOGS OR STUMPS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
