the State of New Jersey, having its principal office at

and State of New Jersey, party of the second part;

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of ONE (\$1.00) DOLLAR  
and other good and valuable consideration,  
lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand well and truly paid by the said

hereby acknowledged, and the said party of the first part being therewith fully satisfied, contented and  
paid, has given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, enfeoffed, conveyed and confirmed and by  
these presents does give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, enfeoff, convey and confirm unto the said  
party of the second part, and to its successors  
and assigns, forever,

All that certain  
tract or parcel of land and premises, hereinafter particularly described, situate, lying and being  
in the Borough of Wanaque, County of Passaic, *PAIS*  
and State of New Jersey:

being *southeastly line, as per survey of Alfred H. Kent*, (said point  
beginning at a point where the *southeastly line, as per survey of Alfred H. Kent*, (said point  
thereon 81.71 feet northwesterly from a point of curve in said Conklintown Road,) said  
point of beginning being in the northeasterly line of lands herein described, and  
easterly line of the former right of way of the New York and Greenwood Lake Railroad  
Company, and running thence

1) South 22 degrees 08 minutes West and passing along the westerly line of  
the Conklintown Substation, and also passing along the westerly line of Sherman Avenue


