RE: Encroachment Wanaque River (Ringwood Creek)

## Gentlemen:

This is with reference to your recent application for approval to construct a sanitary landfill along Ringwood Creek (Peters Mine Brook), to relocate the channel of the stream and construct a culvert in the vicinity of Peters Mine Road in the Borough of Ringwood, Passaic County.

Your application was considered by the Water Policy and Supply Council at its meeting of May 17, 1971 at which time it was determined that there could be a potential pollution problem which might be detrimental to the water supply in the Wanaque Reservoir which is fed by the subject stream and the Council, therefore, declined to grant approval. It was noted that the present landfill is being conducted in a manner unsatisfactory to the Bureau of Solid Waste Management.

Should you desire to pursue this matter further, you may request a public hearing to be held before the Water Policy and Supply Council at which time you would be given the opportunity to present testimony and reasons why your application should be approved.
