Dear Mr. Pellegrini:

This is to formally request that I.S.A. in New Jersey, Inc. be excluded from further involvement in the current project concerned with the establishment of a sanitary landfill in Ringwood, New Jersey.

We have arrived at this decision based on the following considerations:

- (1) The controlling agencies in the area have proposed stringent construction and operational requirements for this sanitary landfill project, which would result in a very substantial capital investment and high operating costs.
- (2) The amount of land proposed for this project is sufficient to provide only short-term operation based on projected input volumes.
- (3) Because of previous, improper dumping operations in the proposed landfill area, a constant, prolonged monitoring and/or water treatment system could be required for years after cessation of landfill operations in the area.

In short, although I.S.A. in New Jersey, Inc. has already willingly expended a considerable effort, especially in the areas of Engineering

and permit acquisition, we feel that we can no longer substantiate future expense on this project.
