Lil' Dribblers Soccer

1. Who can participate?

Ringwood residents ages 3-5 years old at the start of the program. Kindergarteners are not eligible.

2. When are games?

At this age, official games are not held. This is instructional. Occasional scrimmages are played during regular practice time.

3. When are practices?

Practices are held Sunday mornings at 10:00am. Sessions are held at various times throughout the year depending on interest, coach availability and field availability.

4. Where do games/practices occur?

Lower Ryerson Field

5. When is the season?

The season runs in the fall (September-November). Depending on interest and coach availability, the program can run again in the spring (April-May) and winter (January-February).

6. What equipment is needed?

Each player must wear shin guards and soccer cleats or closed toed sneakers. Families are responsible for providing these as well as shorts for their player/s. Each player is given a uniform shirt. Each player should also have a size 3 soccer ball, although spares are available in case someone is in need.

7. What else do I need to know?

Coaches are volunteer-based and are always welcomed and needed at every level!
