# Septic Installation Guidance for Homeowners

- 1. Septic Design submitted with \$75.00 fee for health department review.
- 2. Once the septic design is approved, an approval letter along with the approved design and the health department fee sheet is mailed to homeowner.
- 3. Homeowner signs the fee sheet and gives to the contracted installer.

## \*\* Homeowner's Responsibility:

- A. <u>IF THE SEPTIC DESIGN INCLUDES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING ADVANCED PRE-TREATMENT UNITS(ATU):</u>
  - HOOT
  - JET
  - FUJICLEAN
  - ECOFLO
  - PURAFLO PEAT PODS
  - NORWECO
  - PRESBY ADVANCED ENVIRO SEPTIC SYSTEMS
  - OTHER ATUs
  - \*\*A SIGNED SERVICE AGREEMENT IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE SIGNED BY THE HOMEOWNER PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OF THE UNIT.
- B. IF THE APPROVAL LETTER STATES THAT A 'DEED RESTRICTION' IS REQUIRED:
  - HOMEOWNER MUST NOTIFY THEIR ATTORNEY TO INCLUDE INFORMATION REGARDING ATU ON THE PROPERTY DEED.

#### \*\* SEPTIC INSTALLER'S RESPONSIBILTY:

- OBTAIN SEPTIC INSTALLATION PERMIT FROM THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT.
- PRIOR TO RECEIVING THE PERMIT, the Installer must provide the health department with the signed fee sheet and the following (when applicable):
  - Electrical permit
  - Plumbing permit
  - Signed Service Contract

## \*\* HEALTH DEPARTMENT'S RESPONSIBILITY:

- A. THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT MUST PERFORM THE FOLLOWING INSPECTIONS DURING THE SEPTIC INSTALLATION:
  - Open bed
  - Suitable fill
  - Final installation
  - Final grade

### \*\*ENGINEER'S RESPONSIBILITY:

- A. THE DESIGN ENGINEER IS REQUIRED TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING INSPECTIONS AND MEASUREMENTS DURING THE SEPTIC INSTALLATION:
  - Open bed
  - Suitable Fill inspection, to include sample of fill and fill certification
  - Final installation
  - Final Grade
- B. Upon final grade inspection and measurements, the engineer will draw up the final As-Built. The sealed As-Built along with the signed and sealed Certificate of Compliance is submitted to the health department.

THE HEALTH DEPARMENT WILL ISSUE *A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION* once all THE FOLLOWING FINAL DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

- Engineer's Certificate of Compliance and As-Built
- Copy of Deed Restriction (if applicable- for Advanced Pretreatment Systems)
- Signed Service Agreement (for Advanced Pretreatment Systems- ATU)
- Septic Tank Certification (from engineer and/or installer)
- Final electrical and plumbing approvals
- Other site specific documentation when applicable
